A pair of Doulton Lambeth stoneware vases, circa 1887, decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, each tapered body with a frieze of playful rabbits between banded decoration, incised and impressed marks to bases, height 19cm (one with chip to footrim).

Estimate: £600 - £800

Condition Report

1480. Vase 1 - chip to foot rim, approx 2cm in length, majority of chip damage underneath base, only a few millimetres noticeable on rim edge. Otherwise ok.

Vase 2 - In good condition. A small manufacturing fault to the shoulder decoration, where an excess of glaze had gathered and later come away from the body.
