A large Staffordshire pottery figure of Wallace, late 19th century, modelled standing on a tiled base, height 42.5cm, a similar figure of a huntsman, a figure of Bruce, two spill holders, modelled with swans, and two other Staffordshire figure groups of Highland dancers (minor restoration).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1486. All with typical crazing to glaze.

Bruce - some typical flaking to enamels, gilding worn. Otherwise ok. Black re-touched.

Large Highland Dancer - professionally restored through neck.

Wallace - gilding rubbed, very minor enamel flaking.

Scottish Couple Dancing - chip to her nose and faint horizontal haircrack to her back.

White glazed couple - 2 minor chips to footrim, gilding and enamels worn and rubbed.

Swans with cygnets - one adult swan with professionally restored wing tip and neck, and associated cygnet with restored head. Otherwise ok.

Other Swan spill - vertical crack to side of spill holder.
