A Vincennes bleu lapis ground porcelain cup and saucer, circa 1750, the cup gilt with a foliate spray between laurel bands and a scrolling ribbon to the rim, spaced with stylized leaves, unmarked, diameter of saucer 11.5cm. Note: a similar cup and saucer was sold in these rooms 3rd December 2015, Lot 1575.

### Condition Report

1559. No chips, cracks or repairs. Gilding typically rubbed/worn. Extensive surface scratching to surface of saucer, less so to blue exterior of cup. Black speckled markings visible to glaze on underside of saucer - a manufacturing issue.
