A Meissen porcelain Academic period teacup and saucer, circa 1770, painted in purpurmalerei with gilt enriched Kakiemon type flowers, crossed swords in underglaze blue to bases with dot, diameter of saucer 13.3cm, together with a similar Meissen teacup and saucer, painted with Deutsche Blumen in purpurmalerei, diameter of saucer 12.3cm.

Estimate: £180 - £220

Condition Report

1558. Kakiemon type flowers - saucer possibly matched as large for size of cup. Cup with minor blemish to footrim, otherwise no chips, cracks or repairs. Gilding almost totally worn on rim of cup, less so on rim of saucer. Typical light surface wear/scratches.

Deutsche Blumen - fritted nibbling to footrim of cup with almost totally rubbed gilt rim, saucer a bit worn with rubbing to gilt rim and minor spot of professional restoration to edge.
