### LOT 1506

A Linthorpe Pottery collapsed rim vase, circa 1880, with green and yellow running glaze to the exterior, brown glazed interior, unmarked, height 7cm, together with a Linthorpe vase, decorated with pine, height 8cm (restored), and another art pottery vase, height 19cm. Note: a similar collapsed rim vase from Christopher Dresser's own collection is illustrated in 'Christopher Dresser' by Widar Halén, plate 188.

Estimate: £40 - £60

### Condition Report

1506. Collapsed rim vase - 2 sizeable chips to base edge, 2 small chips to inner rim edge, typical crazing to glaze. Unmarked.

Vase with pine - rim extensively professionally restored but noticeable due to colour difference and lack of crazing here, with later glued repair too. Glaze blemishes to body overall. 'Linthorpe' mark to base with indistinct numerals.

Other vase - minor glaze nick to footrim, fine crazing to glaze of neck. Unmarked.
