LOT 1494

A Vienna porcelain saucer, late 18th/early 19th century, painted with gilt enriched Indianische Blumen, underglaze blue and impressed marks to base, diameter 14cm, together with a group of Continental porcelain cabinet cups and saucers, including a gilt lined can, enamelled with a frieze of figures, the saucer well with a hunt, and a Meissen style Vienna cup and saucer with Deutsche Blumen, various marks (some faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1494. Vienna saucer - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Very insignificant rubbing to gilt rim.

Gilt lined can and saucer - starcrack to cup and crack to lower handle terminal, interior base gilding of cup totally rubbed. Saucer ok.

Vienna cup and saucer with Deutsche Blumen - surface wear and scratches to saucer, light rubbing to gilding overall.

Swan handled cup and saucer - faint starcrack to saucer and gilt rim rubbed. Cup with crack to upper handle terminal.

Gilt scattered flowers cup and saucer - gilding worn and rubbed.

Similar saucer - gilding worn to well.

Gilt lined floral can - ok. Similar saucer with surface wear.

Blue flower banded cup and saucer - faint starcrack to well of saucer.

Green ground and floral cup and saucer - saucer cracked, both pieces heavily worn.

Scattered Floral cup and saucer with large green leaves - saucer cracked, significant wear overall.

Pair cups and saucers with violets - one cup with chip to rim, gilding worn overall.
