Condition Report

1566. Approx one quarter section of box broken away in one section and visibly repaired, some minor losses along the break line, the gilt metal mounts have therefore been restuck into position. Minor and indistinct chip to inner front rim edge of box and lower inner rim edge of lid. Otherwise the exterior is particularly scratched and worn. Glazed over manufacturers chip to upper right corner of lid where green butterfly wing is.
