Four pieces of pearlware with blue painted chinoiserie decoration, late 18th/early 19th century, comprising a large and a small coffee pot and cover, heights 26cm and 19cm, a two-handled sucrier and cover, probably Leeds, height 9cm, and a similar two-handled pot, height 7.5cm, together with a creamware footed dish, diameter 11cm (extensive faults and repairs throughout). Provenance: from the collection of Jennifer Moody.

Condition Report

1529. Large coffee - cover extensively broken and visibly glued. Body in generally good order with minor fritting to spout rim.

Small coffee - flange of cover restored, crazed. Body heavily crazed with restoration to tip of spout.

Sucrier and cover and footed dish - both extensively broken and visibly repaired.

2 handled pot - crazed, losses to each handle terminal, minor restoration to rim.
