A Royal Worcester porcelain potpourri vase, liner and cover, circa 1910, the bulbous body painted by Jas Stinton, signed, with a male and female pheasant above a moulded gilt enriched lower body, flanked by blush ivory angular and foliate handles beneath the pierced neck and domed cover, puce printed mark to base with shape No. '1995', height 18.5cm (cover restored).

### Condition Report

1433. Cover extensively professionally but noticeably poorly restored.

Insignificant tiny nicks to edge of liner.

Main vase with minor nick to tip of acanthus leaf detail of one handle's lower terminal, otherwise in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration, but the gilding is noticeably worn/rubbed to the handles and neck.
