A set of four George III silver wine coasters, each with flared rim and reeded sides above a turned wooden base, London 1812 and 1813, diameters 15.3cm.

Condition Report

360. All coasters in similar condition. All are generally ok but do have some dents and misshaping to rims. All have general wear and surface scratches commensurate with age. All with small dents to reeding on body. Marks are rubbed and some easier to read than others as they have less rubbing. Maker's mark not visible. No apparent splits or holes. Turned wood bases a bit dirty but all in good order and all have retained their silver central bosses. All would benefit from a clean.
