A mid-19th century diamond and dark blue enameled, silver set and gold backed oval brooch, designed as an urn within a floral and foliate surround, mounted with rose cut diamonds and an outer border of rose cut diamonds, the back of the brooch engraved with a floral and foliate motif, possibly French, width 3.2cm.

Condition Report

540. The silver setting is heavily tarnished. The rose diamonds look to be attractive white stones, some with a few black piqué inclusions. Weight 8.9g. The enamel appears to be in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches visible under magnification, but of no real consequence. A bit dusty and dirty and would benefit from a clean.

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
