A gold, diamond, ruby and half-pearl brooch, designed as a butterfly with outspread wings, mounted with five cushion shaped rubies, half-pearls and variously cut diamonds, width 4.3cm.

Estimate: £700 - £900

Condition Report

606. The rubies are of medium colour saturation. The diamonds have one or two surface reaching inclusions. Most of these diamonds are inverted old cut diamonds showing their undersides to the viewer. The three pearls do not quite match, the pearl nearest to the ruby of the body has adhesive surrounding it. The brooch fittings have been repositioned in the past. Weight 13.7g.
