A three row necklace of graduated pearls, probably natural saltwater, on a diamond cluster clasp, collet set with the principal cushion shaped diamond within a surround of smaller cushion shaped diamonds, length of shortest strand 39cm, smallest pearl diameter approx 0.2cm, largest pearl diameter approx 0.7cm.

Condition Report

607. There is no test certificate to accompany the lot, however the description of 'probably natural saltwater' would be the opinion of a specialist. The diamonds to the clasp slightly draw colour. The principal diamond looks to be fairly clear but it is also dirty and would benefit from careful professional cleaning. Principal diamond weight approx. 0.60cts. Total gross weight of necklace: 25.8g.

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
