A white gold and diamond brooch, the top of cut cornered square openwork design, collet set with a central principal cushion shaped diamond, hung with a large pendant pear shaped drop, length 4.8cm.

Condition Report

724. It is possible that the top cut cornered square brooch is in association with the drop. The diamonds are generally attractive white stones. The principal diamonds are all old cut stones. The principal diamond at the top of the brooch has a black piqué inclusion beneath the table facet. This diamond slightly draws colour. Principal diamond approx. 0.80-0.90ct. Clarity approx. SI. Colour approx. J. Weight 5.4g.

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
