A group of Victorian and later mourning and other jewellery, comprising five pendants and lockets, a pendant locket, fitted to a gilt metal collar chain, two oval hinged bangles, five brooches, five necklaces, a pair of colourless gem set cluster earstuds and a Kenwell lady's wristwatch.

Condition Report

719. All pieces with typical light surface scratches and wear commensurate with age.

Black portrait locket pendant - good condition.

Small oval portrait locket - small chip and crack to hinge, otherwise ok.

Square black pendant - generally good condition.

Oval black brooch - minor chips to edges.

Large oval black locket - good condition, small hairline to back panel and black worn off suspension loop.

Oval locket with paste crucifix motif - missing two pastes to cross, typical light wear and a few nicks to edges.

Black heart pendant and bead neckchain - generally good condition.

2 x black bead necklaces - one has a broken heart bead, otherwise ok. Other in good condition.

2 x black brooches - both with nicks and chips and surface abrasions.

Black and marcasite brooch - 3 marcasites missing, otherwise ok.

Both bangles ok, but with wear.

Other pieces all with typical wear.

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
