Condition Report

684. The ring is in generally good condition commensurate with age. Good clear hallmarks. Typical light surface scratches and wear to mounts. Stones have surface abrasions visible under magnification and one diamond has a surface reaching inclusion to edge of the stone and both with other inclusions visible under magnification.
