Condition Report

400. The teapot is in very good condition commensurate with age with only typical minor light surface wear and scratches. Hinge is good with only minor movement. Lid closes nice and tight. Body in good order with only a couple of very minor dents. Minor misshaping to end of spout. Some wear to ebonizing on handle and minor split to top of handle. No significant damage or repairs. Good clear hallmarks. Weight 486.7g.
