A George III mahogany kettle stand, the serpentine top above a fluted frieze, the corners with rosette mounts, raised on delicate stop fluted tapering downswept legs terminating in brass caps and castors, height 69.5cm, width 34cm (faults and alterations).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

2012. Clearly in need of considerable restoration with detached leg and lacking some elements, including two rosette mounts and the slide. Four of the carved scroll corner brackets at the top of the legs are also missing, as well as two sections of the fluted frieze. Sections of the beaded moulding below the frieze and corner moulding of top also not present. Cracks to frieze, but no actual breaks through the legs. The top is water stained and badly re-polished and we are not entirely convinced whether it is original to the piece.
