A pair of 18th century floral marquetry elm and walnut vase back dining chairs, each back inlaid with a cherub supporting a vase of flowers above a drop-in seat, on carved cabriole legs, height 100cm, width 56cm.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

2192. Chair 1 - some old historic woodworm scattered throughout, but not damaging the chair structurally. There are two old cracks running down through the top of the frieze/leg joint and some loss to the veneers on seat rail. Later supports added to seat rail corners and spliced section of replaced elm on rear seat rail below back.

Chair 2 - some areas of light historic woodworm overall, numerous areas of minor loss to veneered edges of back, seat rails and top edge of seat rail. Some minor surface cracks to seat rails on leg joint areas. Later corner supports to seat rails and later screw repairs to back of rear leg joint. Crack to hip of back. Both chairs with small areas of loss and re-veneering overall.
