A late 19th century Middle Eastern ebonized bijouterie table, inset with overall panels of finely turned mashrabiya and profusely inlaid in bone and mother-of-pearl, the hinged top inset with a bevelled glass panel enclosing a mirrored interior, raised on carved knob and spiral fluted legs, height 82cm, width 72.5cm, depth 57cm (some faults).
