A group of five copper jelly moulds, including a pair by Benham & Froud, numbered '1A' and '70A', lengths 18cm, and an Alexandra Cross mould, stamped 'Registered April 29 1863', diameter 13cm (faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

2519. Alexandra Cross mould - badly dented and impressed in to the base with soldering to the corners. Diameter 14cm. Has holes to most of the corners of the base joints where the body has been pressed in.

Pair of moulds - both have minor surface wear and some minor dents overall, but otherwise ok. Both are 18cm x 10cm.

Smallest mould - has overall surface dent to the domed reeded area and is slightly misshapen. Diameter 5cm.

Lobed circular mould - some surface dents and areas of flattening. Diameter 12cm.
