A Chinese famille verte porcelain teapot, Kangxi period, with carved wood cover, the baluster body moulded in relief as vertical bamboo, painted with chrysanthemum flowers alternating with patterned stripes, the spout and handle moulded as bamboo, the cover as a chrysanthemum, unmarked, height 12cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1017. Small firing crack to neck approx 2cm long, also some minor chips to rim, small chip to tip of spout, starcrack to base. Otherwise in generally good order with typical surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze. Replacement wooden cover is a good fit.
