Condition Report

62. Some fading with associated muting of colour. General age toning throughout. A few spots of foxing most noticeable to the sky on the right-hand side. Mark running vertically down the right-hand side about 2cm away from mount. The work has slipped in the mount. Some detritus trapped between glass and mount. Mount and backing are not archival and would warrant replacing. Oak frame with very minor scuffs and scratches. Unexamined out of the frame.
