Two Chinese Yixing stoneware wine cups, Qing dyansty, each with grey crackle glazed interior and incised with a keyfret band, one of hexagonal form, the other of lobed outline, widths 6cm and 6.6cm (one with rim chips and hairline crack).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1222. Hexagonal bowl - in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Some typical light scuffs to rim and typical light surface scratches and wear.

Lobed bowl - has 3 hairlines running vertically from the rim measuring approx 3, 2 and 2.5cm long. There are also 2 chips to the rim and typical surface scratches and wear.
