A Japanese Imari porcelain floor vase, Meiji period, of baluster form with flared neck, painted with birds and flowers, height 91.5cm, together with a green glazed earthenware vase, moulded in relief with a dragon, height 61cm (repaired).

Condition Report

1241. Japanese vase - appears to be in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs, typical light wear to enamels and gilt and minor surface scratches. Doesn't sit perfectly flat on its base, stands straight but wobbles - a manufacturing issue.

Green vase - head of dragon broken off and reglued, there are also chips to this area as well as the dragon's horns. Otherwise the vase is in generally fairly sound condition with no apparent cracks or repairs.
