A Chinese blue and white porcelain baluster vase, mark of Kangxi but late 19th century, painted with Buddhistic lions and vapours, height 26cm (minor rim chips), together with four Chinese blue and white vases, a famille rose ginger jar and cover and a famille verte ginger jar and cover (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1035. Blue and white baluster vase - 2 small chips/fritting to rim, otherwise in good condition with no cracks, or restoration.

Baluster jar and cover - approx 2.5cm hairline crack to rim and minor chip/flake to rim, otherwise in generally good condition with some small blemishes to glaze and a few minor glaze scuffs to footrim. The associated cover has numerous small chips/fritting to rim, otherwise ok.

Rouleau vase - in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Slight typical wear.

Cylinder vase - small chip to rim, otherwise in good condition.

Crackle glazed blue and white vase - minor chip to rim, lacking cover and light discolouration to glaze.

Famille rose ginger jar and cover - in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Slight typical wear to enamels and glaze.

Famille Verte crackle glazed jar and cover - generally in good condition, some minor wear and some discolouration to glaze.
