A Chinese Canton export lacquer folding fan, mid to late 19th century, the lacquer guards and fourteen sticks painted in gilt with figures in landscapes, supporting a paper panel painted in gouache with continuous figural scenes, each figure with appliqué ivory facial detail, length 27.8cm, within a glazed display case.

Condition Report

1067. The fan overall is in generally poor condition, it is mounted within a closed glazed case so we are unable to inspect both sides of the fan and therefore unable to comment on the condition of the reverse. The side on view has splits to the panel, some paint loss and discolouration to edge/borders, there are also areas where the panel has become detached from the sticks, and one guard appears to have become detached from the panel. One fold is missing approx half of its lower section. The lacquered guard on view also with significant wear to gilding.

The frame of the case has some chips to the gilding and some wear.
