A Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vase, mid-19th century, the shouldered ovoid body and flared neck painted with figural panels within a surround of birds, flowers and precious objects, applied with gilt moulded chilong to shoulders and Buddhistic lion handles to neck, height 42cm (hairline to rim).

1056. Approx 6cm long vertical hairline crack to the rim, starcrack to base, otherwise the vase appears in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Good vibrant enamels with typical light wear to gilding and enamels.
