A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vases, mid to late 19th century, each typically painted with panels of figures, birds and flowers, the neck moulded in relief with an entwined dragon, height 23.5cm.

Condition Report

1048. Vase One - in generally good condition, there is a small chip to the spine of the dragon and one of the horns is chipped, otherwise no cracks or restoration. Typical light wear and surface scratches to enamels and gilt, more pronounced wear to gilt on dragon.

Vase Two - Generally in good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration. Firing crack to neck of dragon, a manufacturing defect, and wear to gilt on dragon, otherwise typical minor surface scratches and wear.
