Condition Report

1190. The plaque is in good condition with no significant damage or repairs, a few very minor scuffs to edges. No apparent cracks or repairs. The stone is a nice uniform colour with no obvious inclusions. Images 1 and 6 probably display the best likeness to the true colour of the plaque. All the images are taken in varying degrees of natural light, hence the differences in each image. The plaque does fit in the stand but we are not 100% certain it is original as it is an awkward fit. The stand is in good condition with a few tiny chips to the feet, but otherwise is ok.
