306. The tankard is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Minor misshaping to rim and a few minor knocks to rim and base. Typical surface wear and scratches. Good clear hallmarks with minor rubbing. Diameter of top approx 5.2cm, diameter of foot approx 5.5cm. Weighs 73g. No engravings, monograms or erasures.
