A George III silver pounce pot, the ovoid body and pierced dome cover chased with flowers and foliate scrolls, on a circular foot, London 1796 by Henry Chawner & John Eames, height 7.7cm, together with a George III silver caddy spoon of leaf form with engraved decoration, London 1796 by Thomas Wallis II, length 10.2cm.

Condition Report

462. Pounce pot - there are a few small dents to the pierced domed cover, typical surface wear to the decoration on the ovoid body, the foot is bent at the stem and there is a small tear to this area, because of this the pot leans slightly to one side. The footrim is slightly misshapen, hallmark to base is good and clear. Caddy - generally a little thin and tired, small repaired tear to centre of bowl and a few small dents to bowl, otherwise engraving in generally good condition with some surface wear and scratches. Good clear hallmark to back of handle.
