366. Caster - in generally good condition with a few minor dents to body, marks to neck and cover are both a little rubbed but clear and readable.

Cruet bottle - in good condition, no damage or repairs.

Glass caster - generally in good condition, numerous minor chips to high points of cut glass body, otherwise good clear hallmarks.
