A Japanese Satsuma earthenware vase, Meiji period, painted with opposing panels of bijin and arhats, height 12.2cm, together with three other Satsuma vases, two jars and covers and a small group of Japanese porcelain and works of art.

Condition Report

1032. Small Satsuma vase - good condition, minor wear to gilt.

Pair of jars and covers - one cracked and with repaired cover. Both with staining.

Teapot - good condition, no significant damage or repairs, typical light wear.

Oval Kutani box, and cover - firing crack to lie interior and stained crazing to box interior. Otherwise ok.

3 other Satsuma vases - good condition, typical wear.

Sectional bone column - cracks to a few sections.
