LOT 1181

A Chinese rock crystal snuff bottle and cover, late Qing dynasty, of flattened baluster form with carved Buddhistic lion finial above mask and loose ring handles, height 11cm (damaged neck), together with a Chinese carved and stained ivory table screen and slotted stand, height 11cm (faults), and a small group of other South-east Asian works of art.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1181. Rock crystal bottle - neck and rim chipped and damaged and cover glued in place. Other chips to lion handles and minor chips to footrim.

Ivory screen - panel is badly damaged with some losses. Frame is chipped to corner with loss and joints are separating. Stand has two missing green lip supports and splits to feet, but otherwise ok.

Lacquer bowl - good condition.

Coral piece is in two sections and some minor chips to branches.

Other bits in the Lot are less important with some chips and minor damage.
