### LOT 1163

A Chinese famille verte enamelled biscuit porcelain ginger jar and cover, late Qing dynasty, moulded in relief with crane and lotus, height 18.5cm, together with a Chinese famille rose cup, a turquoise glazed octagonal jar, two jade wine cups and two cloisonné dishes (some faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

1163. Green ground ginger jar and cover - firing crack to rim edge of cover which branches into short horizontal haircrack. Jar in good condition overall with minor and light surface scratches.

Cup - minor firing crack to rim and base interior. Gilding rubbed, otherwise ok.

Turquoise jar - extensive surface wear/rubbing to high points. Curved haircrack to rim running vertically and then across top of head of one figure, another vertical haircrack juxtapose to this.

2 jade cups - both with extensive breaks and repairs and some filling.

Cloisonne dishes - one ok, the other extensively damaged.
