A white gold and diamond ring, claw set with the principal circular cut diamond between diamond set three stone shoulders, ring size approx O1/2, detailed '18ct', principal diamond weight approx 0.96ct, with a case.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,000

Condition Report

652. The principal diamond is an attractive white stone, but it does have several piqué and gletz inclusions. The shoulder diamonds are clearer. The ring is a fairly modern manufacture. In relation to resizing it may be possible to reduce the ring size by one or two sizes but to attempt to reduce it more would put too much strain on the security of the claws holding the principal diamond. Weight 3.6g.
