A pair of 18ct white gold, fancy brown diamond and diamond cluster earrings, each claw set with a round brilliant cut fancy brown diamond within a surround of small round brilliant cut diamonds, with post and butterfly fittings, together with accompanying World Gemological Institute certificate stating total fancy brown diamond weight 1.43ct, with a case.

Condition Report

570. The earrings are modern so condition is essentially as new.

The diamond colour between the principal fancy brown stones and the brilliant cut surround is an attractive contrast. They are accompanied by a W.G.I. certificate which states the principal stones are 'Fancy brown round brilliant cut diamonds with a total carat weight of 1.43ct, and a clarity of VS2-SI1. The round brilliant cut diamonds in the surrounds totalling 0.25ct, colour grade G-H and clarity grade V5'.
