A silver medallion commemorating the coronation of King George IV 1821, a group of medallions commemorating aspects of the Peninsular War, a bronze medallion commemorating Tower Bridge 1994, with a Royal Mint case, and a group of further medallions.

Condition Report

1839. Diameter of the large medallion is 7.5cm. The glass is sellotaped in place. The medallion is a silver colour, but it does not look silver, probably some type of plating. There are some tiny chips to the edges of the glass and typical light wear and scratches to the frame. Medallion itself appears to be in generally good order with some minor discolouration and some very minor wear.
