A 19th century forty-eight button concertina by Thomas Dawkins, Charterhouse Street, London, the brass inlaid amboyna ends bearing maker's label and numbered '27190', the gilt tooled brown leather bellows with printed paper panels, within its burr walnut case (maker's label partially inked out).

Condition Report

2503. Seven buttons do not pop back when pressed and a few are a little sticky. The two leather thumb straps are a little worn and the bellows appear to be in good order. The lock on the box is broken and at present is locked on to the lid and detached from the body.

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
