Two similar mid/late 17th century oak joined backstools, South Yorkshire, both with two arched rails carved with scrolls, the recessed panel seats on turned and block legs, height 103cm, width 44cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2099. The chair with the masks carved on the back has a partially filled-in gap in the seat panel, a chip and a crack to the front left foot and some overall scattered historic woodworm. The feet are a bit short and have rubber caps secured to them. The front seat rail has quite a 'baked' rough surface, but otherwise a deep overall patina.

The other chair has some cracks to the seat panel, badly cracked front right upper leg, front seat rail and one of the stretchers. The length of foot is ok, but they do have rubber caps attached.

Both chairs have slightly wobbly joints.
