A violin, bearing interior label detailed 'Jacobus Stainer, in Abfam Prope Oenipontum 16?', with single-piece back, the bridge detailed 'W.E. Hill & Sons', length of back excluding button 35.3cm, together with an ivory mounted bow, branded 'W.E. Hill & Sons', weight of bow 57 grams, within a W.E. Hill & Sons oak case and outer canvas cover.

Condition Report

2570. There are a few very thin hairline cracks running from the right-hand 'f' hole. Other small cracks around the base and sides. The peg holes have been re-drilled at some point and there are the usual surface scuffs and scratches. The bow winder appear to have some very minor hairline to the ivory section.
