A late 17th/early 18th century oak and elm panelled and boarded coffer, the front later carved with lozenges, height 65cm, width 99cm, depth 43cm (faults).

### Condition Report

2136. The top has two later support bars attached to the underside to hold the two planks together. The iron strap hinges are later, as it has lost its original wire hinges. The lock section on the front has a re-patched insert and both upright stile supports are badly cracked and damaged. There is a hole in the right hand panel and the carving on the front is later.
