A 17th century and later elm and oak refectory table, the elm two-plank top with cleated ends, raised on block legs, height 77cm, length 242cm, depth 86cm (alterations and faults).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2101. The top is made from two good sized planks that have later support bars attached to the underside, a large area of discolouration to one end, presumably water damage and a crack to the inside edge of the same end. Also some repairs and cracks to cleats. Overall minor historic woodworm. Some cracks and repairs throughout base, but still very sturdy.
