A William and Mary oak dresser base, the two drawers with deep geometric mouldings bordering panels of oyster veneered laburnum and boxwood stringing, raised on turned baluster and block legs, height 92cm, width 181cm, depth 49.5cm (some alterations).

Condition Report

2130. Condition and appearance overall is quite good. The drawer fronts, front legs and stretchers all have a good rich patina and colour. It appears to have had some work carried out on it at some stage, with what looks like later back legs, back board and possibly a later top. The top is either later or has lost a level of patina that the base has, it also has a large gap in the two pieces of oak that make it up. There is some evidence of woodworm to some of the drawer linings, as well as other areas of minor historic woodworm throughout.
