A 19th century William and Mary style stained oak chest of three long drawers, on turned feet, height 72cm, width 74cm, depth 54cm.

Condition Report

2096. The top panel has a crack running across the middle as well as other more minor cracks. There are cracks to the right side. Some small surface chips to edges and corners. The feet have some old woodworm deterioration to edges, but the rest of the chest appears to be relatively unaffected by woodworm. Three of the handles have been lost and replaced by ring pulls. The drawers all run quite smoothly. This chest was made in the late 19th century in a William and Mary style.
