A late 19th century French slate calendar mantel clock, the two train movement of long duration, probably month going, striking hours and half hours on a bell, the two piece enamel dial with black Roman hour numerals and inner Arabic date ring, the drum case flanked by carved scroll supports, on a plinth base with shaped apron, height 31cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1203. The clock is cosmetically in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical minor nicks and chips to edges of slate and some minor re-touching. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Dial is generally in good order with only very minor scratches visible under magnification. The clock has been tested for over an hour and it is keeping good time and striking on the hour and half hour as it should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
