### LOT 1194

A mid to late 19th century French ormolu and porcelain mantel clock, the eight day movement with silk suspension striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the enamel dial with Roman numerals and inscribed 'Payne', the drum case cast with foliate surround, flanked by a seated putto on a rococo scroll moulded base, framing a Sèvres style porcelain panel, painted with cupids within gilt and bleu céleste borders, height 22cm, with pendulum (some faults).

Estimate: £250 - £350

### Condition Report

1194. The clock is not currently running. The case itself is in generally good condition, but is a bit dirty and dusty, would certainly benefit from a clean. The putto is missing an element from his right index finger. The dial is damaged and paint is peeling away. The pendulum looks to be original.

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
