A Rolex Oyster Perpetual steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1950s, the signed jewelled movement numbered '24893', the signed silvered dial with gilt Arabic numerals and arrow shaped hour markers, Rolex crown at 12 o'clock, gilt and luminous hands and blued steel centre seconds, the winding crown detailed 'Rolex Super Oyster', numbered between the lugs '736140' and '6084', the milled screw-off case back interior numbered '6084', case diameter 3.2cm, on a later strap.

Condition Report

1080. The rotor winds as it should and it is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The watch adjust smoothly.

Case in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs, typical surface scratches and wear. Case a bit dirty and would benefit from a clean.

Glass is scratched with a few more significant scratches around the centre and a crack to edge between 5 o'clock and 6 o'clock.

The dial is a little tired with some degrading to gilt on numerals, batons, crown and lettering. There is also some ghosting around the numerals visible under magnification. Black lettering and detail is good.
