## LOT 1055

A Longines stainless steel cased gentleman's chronograph wristwatch, circa 1959, Ref. No. 6552, the signed and jewelled 30CH calibre movement numbered '11053119', the signed silvered dial with silvered Arabic numerals and baton hour markers, outer telemeter scale and two subsidiary dials, the signed case back interior numbered '6552 3' over '19', case diameter 3.75cm, on a brown leather strap. Note: accompanied by a correspondence from Longines stating that this watch was billed to Danero, the agent for Uruguay at the time, on the 12th July 1962.

Estimate: £3,000 - £5,000

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## Condition Report

1055. The watch is in generally good clean condition. Case has typical minor surface scratches, but not significant damage or repairs. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently in good working order with all chrono functions working as they should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The dial appears in good order, under magnification some spotting and specks can be seen.

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
